Sunscreen Permission Form

Chapter 242 of the laws of 2013 amended the New York State Public Health Law to allow children attending camp to carry and use topical sunscreen products approved by the federal Food and Drug Administration for over-the-counter use for the purpose of avoiding overexposure to the sun and not for medical treatment of an injury or illness, so long as written permission of the person in parental relation to the pupil is provided. A record of such permission shall be maintained in the camp office. A child who is unable to physically apply sunscreen may be assisted by unlicensed personnel when directed to do so by the child, if permitted by a parent or guardian and authorized by the camp.

I hereby give permission for my child to use the sunscreen (s)he has brought or the camp has supplied, which is approved by the FDA for over the counter use to avoid overexposure to the sun. Our child(ren) may be assisted by unlicensed staff if (s)he requests.
